<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will be continuing our unit on Building Relationships- My friends and family. Lesson 3- What makes a good friend? This week we will be talking about how we feel about snails and worms and how to look after our snail.
Communication and Language	Poetry basket- A Little Shell We will be describing our snail- what does it feel like to hold him?
Physical Development	We will be continuing our unit on Movement Development. This week we will be working on Exploring movements. We will be exploring moving like different animals. We will also be playing a game called "Do this, Do that" where the children need to follow instructions. Similar to Simon says, children can only do the action when "Do this" is said.
