<u>Subject</u>	<u>Overview</u>
English	We will be describing characters from Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs.
Maths	Year 1 will be consolidating their Measurement unit on mass and volume, as well as completing an assessment on length and height.  Year 2 will be consolidating their Multiplication and Division unit.
Science	The class will discuss what we have learned this term about seasonal changes.
